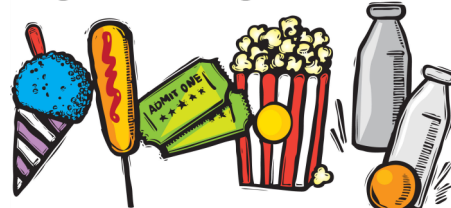
END OF SUMMER CARNIVAL

The Friendship House at Michigan State University is seeking volunteers to teach our international students, beginning in September. These positions provide amazing opportunities to minister to people from around the world.

What you need to know:
